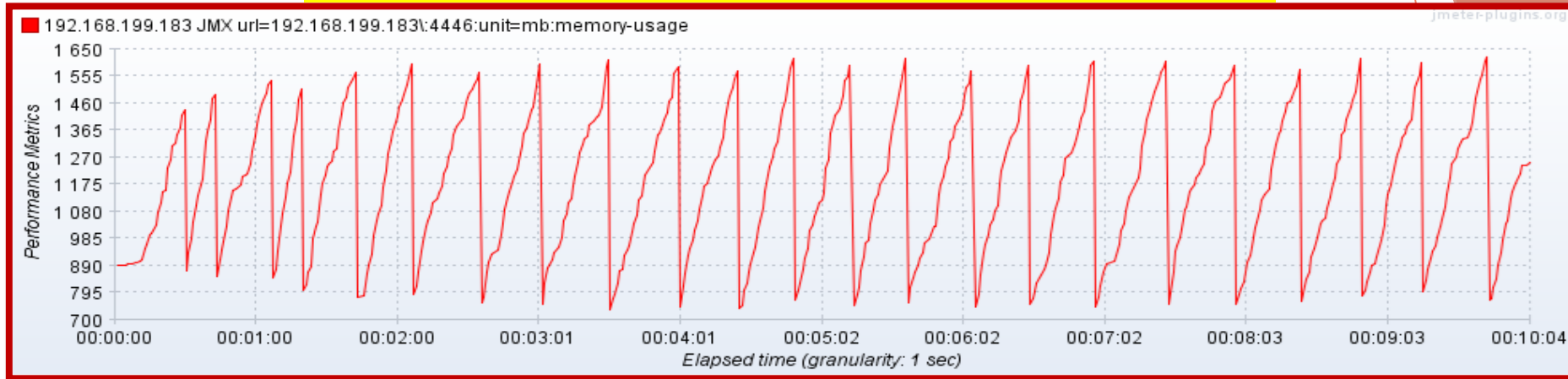

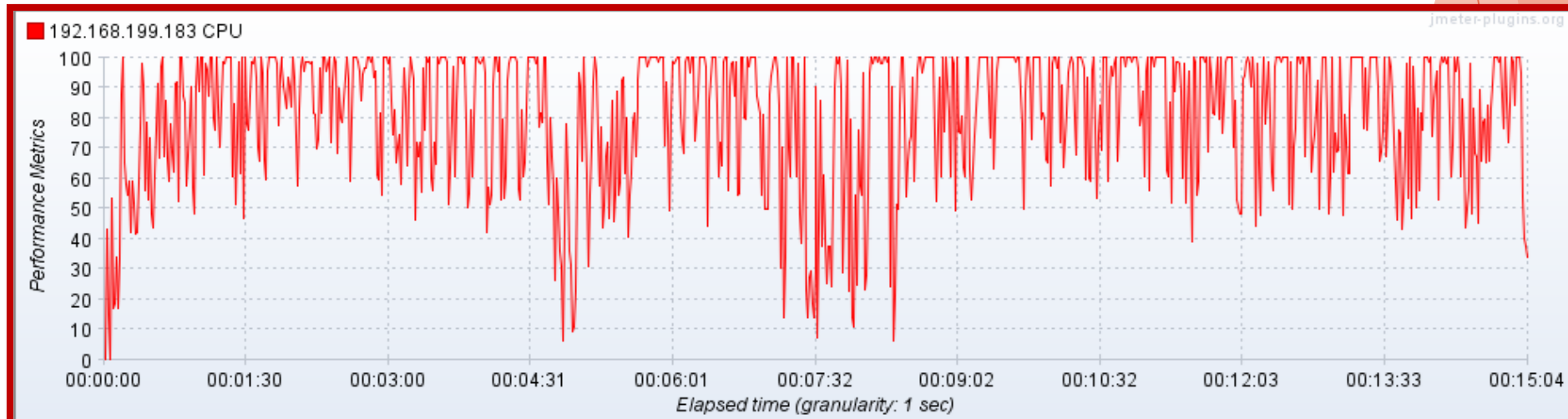
HEAP MEMORY UTILIZATION:
